The 2015 Echézeaux Grand Cru wafts from the glass with a deep bouquet of smoked meats, cassis, blackberries, incense and rich soil tones. On the palate, it's full-bodied, velvety and enveloping, with rich but supple tannins, a deep and concentrated core of fruit, lively acids and a long, thrillingly carnal finish. This is a beautifully made Echézeaux from this challenging frost vintage.

I will be making an overdue visit to Lucien Le Moine's Mounir Saouma this year, so a full report on this important micro-négociant operation will appear in the near future. In the meantime, I tasted a few of the Le Moine 2015s in my US office, and my notes on those wines are published here.
